



The Missions Committee involvement with Adventist Health International resulted in a true blessing. With the support of benevolent donors, over \$120,000 was raised for the medical missionary work our alumni tirelessly perform worldwide.

Waterloo Hospital, Sierra Leone. James '16 and Rachel Fernando will arrive at their mission hospital where donations built a new home with a second home in the midst of renovation for the 2 doctor families stationed there.

Nepal. Jonathon '12 and Allie Thorp successively have had their visas extended. The goal of a new respiratory lab, the first in this country, was made possible by donations from the auxiliary.

Haiti. Scott '96 and Marni Nelson have permanently moved here to continue the work in this country slow to recover after a devastating earthquake. Construction of new, safe apartments for medical students and residents are scheduled for this year and will improve this site as a Global Campus for Loma Linda University.

Tchad. Danae '06 and Olen '07 Netteburg along with Sarah Belensky '13 have overseen the completion of a modern operating suite. Soon, the operating room will be ready for the addition of a new surgeon at Bere Adventist Hospital.

Honduras. Joel '06 and Jennifer Mundall will be able to expand long term care with a new wing. Modern electrical upgrades will need to be added to existing structures so that the new wing will be compatible. They remain dedicated to medical mission work made possible with support from auxiliary members.

Liberia. Cooper Adventist Hospital received funds this last year to complete renovation of the operating room in this aging facility. Gillian Seton '08 is well known to our alumni family for her brave work during the Ebola crisis.

Malawi. Malamulo Hospital is the site of another Global Campus, part of Loma Linda University. With four alumni families living here (Gobble '12, Hayton '05, Graybill '05, Thomas '13), education buildings were desperately needed. With leadership passion, it was decided that additional funds amounting to over \$40,000 would be sent here. The classrooms are built, supplies sent, and students will arrive in just a few short weeks.

Students requiring assistance to attend Global Mission electives were also given funds by Medical Auxiliary this last year. The future of medical missionary work rests with these students, and the Mission Committee remains dedicated to the vision of medical ministry with Jesus as the ultimate healer.

Farewell letter from the Past President, Alice Yeo
